- How do I best communicate with my child who has auditory comprehension/ difficulties?
- How do I understand what my non-verbal child is telling me?
- Why does my child respond more to his therapists than me?
- What are more positive ways to communicate with my child?
- How can I help my child calm down when he/she is upset?
- What sensory integration approaches might help?
